A RESOLUTION to recognize the Stax Museum for outstanding community leadership.

WHEREAS, an exemplary organization, the Stax Museum is committed to excellence and community service that is representative of the Volunteer State, and it should be specially recognized; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE HUNDRED TENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, that we honor and commend the Stax Museum for its outstanding community leadership, applaud its efforts toward the enhancement, growth, and development of the 86th House District, and extend to it our best wishes for continued success in its future endeavors.
