WHEREAS, for his Eagle project, Braden Cupp designed and helped create a veterans memorial at Cherokee Park in Morristown. His efforts included raising \$7,000 in donations from local businesses and organizations for the project and working many Saturdays and hours after school; and

WHEREAS, the successful completion of the veterans memorial greatly contributed to the betterment of his community and reflected the true spirit of volunteerism; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate that we should pause to recognize Braden Cupp as one of the most outstanding young people in our State; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDRED TENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING, that we hereby honor and congratulate Braden Cupp on becoming an Eagle Scout and being nominated to the Order of the Arrow and extend to him our best wishes for every future success.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that an appropriate copy of this resolution be prepared for presentation with this final clause omitted from such copy.
