SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 263

A RESOLUTION to confirm the appointment of Keith Jordan as a director of the Tennessee regulatory authority.

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 65-1-101, creates the Tennessee regulatory authority; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 65-1-101, provides that two (2) directors of the Tennessee regulatory authority shall be appointed by joint agreement among the governor, the speaker of the senate, and the speaker of the house of representatives; and

WHEREAS, Governor Bill Haslam, Lieutenant Governor Randy McNally, and Speaker Beth Harwell have jointly appointed Keith Jordan to serve as a director of the Tennessee regulatory authority for the remainder of an unexpired term that will expire on June 30, 2018; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Jordan has been engaged in private law practice for more than thirty years; and

WHEREAS, he previously served his fellow citizens as a member of the Tennessee Senate, representing the 23rd District, during the 97th through 100th General Assemblies; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Jordan is a graduate of Dartmouth College and received his J.D. from Vanderbilt University Law School; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Jordan's extensive experience in both the public and private sectors will be valuable to the Tennessee regulatory authority; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 65-1-101, provides that each appointment to the Tennessee regulatory authority shall be confirmed by joint resolution adopted by each house of the general assembly; now, therefore,


