## **SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 535**

A RESOLUTION to confirm the appointment of Lang Wiseman of Memphis to the State Board of Education.

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-1-301, provides for the creation of the State Board of Education; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-1-301, further provides that the Governor shall appoint nine members to the State Board of Education; and

WHEREAS, Governor Bill Haslam has appointed Lang Wiseman of Memphis to the State Board of Education to a term that commenced July 10, 2017, and expires March 31, 2019, as a member representing the 8th Congressional District; and

WHEREAS, a highly respected member of his community, Lang Wiseman practices law at Wiseman Bray PLLC; he is a Tennessee Supreme Court Rule 31 Listed Civil Mediator; and

WHEREAS, prior to founding Wiseman Bray PLLC, Mr. Wiseman served as Counsel to the United States Senate Governmental Affairs Committee, and he previously served as a Law Clerk to Judge Harry Wellford of the U.S. Sixth Circuit Court of Appeals; and

WHEREAS, Lang Wiseman is a person of integrity and an active citizen whose benevolence, acumen, and strong commitment to public service have helped to enhance the well-being of this State and its citizens; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-1-301, provides that each member appointed by the Governor to the State Board of Education shall be subject to confirmation by each house of the General Assembly; now, therefore,


