WHEREAS, a principal designee, Michelle Newman is a new teacher mentor, grade-level team leader, and data team member; she is a member of the Hamblen County science textbook adoption committee and a science content leader; and

WHEREAS, no stranger to honors and awards, Mrs. Newman is the current Tennessee Science Teachers Association Teacher of the Year for kindergarten through fourth grade, and she was selected to serve on the state's science textbook committee; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Newman is an inspiration to her colleagues and students alike, and her friendship and counsel are highly valued by those who are fortunate to know her; and


