HOUSE BILL NO. 1523

AN ACT to amend Chapter 23 of the Private Acts of 2013; and any other acts amendatory thereto, relative to the tax on the privilege of occupancy in Cannon County.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of Chapter 23 of the Private Acts of 2013, and any other acts amendatory thereto, is amended by adding the following at the end of subsection (4):

"Hotel" does not include a nonprofit campground that includes a portion of the camp fee for housing.

SECTION 2. This act shall have no effect unless it is approved by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the legislative body of Cannon County. Its approval or nonapproval shall be proclaimed by the presiding officer of the legislative body and certified to the secretary of state.

SECTION 3. For the purpose of approving or rejecting the provisions of this act, it shall be effective upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it. For all other purposes, it shall become effective as provided in Section 2.
