## PRIVATE CHAPTER NO. 26

HOUSE BILL NO. 1532

AN ACT to amend Chapter 644 of the Private Acts of 1911; as amended by Chapter 685 of the Private Acts of 1929, Chapter 52 of the Private Acts of 2016; and any other acts amendatory thereto, relative to the Charter of the City of Lebanon.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Article V, Section 1 of Chapter 644 of the Private Acts of 1911, as amended by Chapter 685 of the Private Acts of 1929, Chapter 52 of the Private Acts of 2016, and any other acts amendatory thereto, is amended by deleting the following language "Nothing in this charter shall be construed as granting a property interest to any employee or department head in their continued employment" in subdivision (B)(5).

SECTION 2. This act shall have no effect unless it is approved by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the legislative body of the City of Lebanon. Its approval or nonapproval shall be proclaimed by the presiding officer of the legislative body and certified to the secretary of state.

SECTION 3. For the purpose of approving or rejecting the provisions of this act, it shall be effective upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it. For all other purposes, it shall become effective as provided in Section 2.
