### **HOUSE BILL NO. 189**

#### By Senator Yager

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 36, Chapter 3, relative to marriage.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 36-3-106, is amended by deleting the language "sixteen (16) years of age" wherever it appears and substituting instead the language "seventeen (17) years of age".

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 36-3-106, is amended by adding the following as a new subsection:

- (g) As used in this section, "parent" or "parents" means a person or persons listed as a parent on the child's birth certificate or who have been adjudicated to be the legal parent of the child by a court of competent jurisdiction.
- SECTION 3. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 36-3-104, is amended by deleting subsection (b) in its entirety.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect July 1, 2019, the public welfare requiring it.
