AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 15, Chapter 2, Part 1, relative to Mrs. Rosa L. Parks Day.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 15, Chapter 2, Part 1, is amended by adding the following as a new section:

December 1 of each year is to be observed as "Mrs. Rosa L. Parks Day" to be proclaimed as such by the governor, to honor and recognize Mrs. Rosa L. Parks for her important role in the civil rights movement in the United States. This day is not a legal holiday as defined in § 15-1-101.


SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
