AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 55, Chapter 7, Part 2, relative to
overdimensional and overweight loads.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 55-7-205, is amended by adding the
following as a new subsection:

() Notwithstanding subsections (e)-(g) or any other law to the contrary, an applicant
for the issuance or renewal of a special permit for the movement of an oversize motor
vehicle, or trailer or semitrailer, whose height, including the load, may exceed the limits
prescribed in § 55-7-202 is not required, as a condition for the issuance or renewal of the
permit, to complete or submit a route survey of the proposed route of travel unless the height
of the vehicle and load exceeds fifteen feet six inches (15'6").


SECTION 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2019, the public welfare requiring it.
