AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 55, Chapter 4, relative to personalization of certain plates.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:


SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 55-4-214, is amended by adding the following as a new subsection:

(e) Notwithstanding subdivisions (c)(8) and (c)(10), memorial plates, as enumerated in § 55-4-203(c)(4) and defined in § 55-4-250, and military plates, as enumerated in § 55-4-203(c)(5)(E), are eligible for personalization pursuant to this section. In addition to any other fees required by this section or by this part for the issuance of such plates, an applicant for the personalization of memorial or military plates shall pay a fee equal to the cost of actually designing and manufacturing the personalized plates. Nothing in this subsection (e) authorizes the removal or other redesign of any distinctive identification legend or letters required to be included on memorial or military plates.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2019, the public welfare requiring it.
