AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 4, Chapter 29 and Title 23, Chapter 1, relative to the board of law examiners.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 4-29-241(a), is amended by deleting subdivision (7).

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 4, Chapter 29, Part 2, is amended by adding the following as a new section:

#### 4-29-249.

- (a) The following governmental entities terminate on June 30, 2028:
  - () Board of law examiners, created by § 23-1-101;
- (b) Each department, commission, board, agency, or council of state government created during calendar year 2026 terminates on June 30, 2028.
- (c) Any governmental entity that has been terminated under this section may be continued, reestablished, or restructured in accordance with this chapter.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
