AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 4, Chapter 29 and Title 62, Chapter 6, Part 1, relative to the state board for licensing contractors.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 4-29-241(a), is amended by deleting subdivision (45).

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 4-29-247(a), is amended by adding the following as a new subdivision:

() State board for licensing contractors, created by § 62-6-104;

SECTION 3. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 62-6-104(b), is amended by deleting the subsection and substituting instead the following:

(b)(1) Any member who misses more than fifty percent (50%) of the scheduled meetings in a calendar year shall be removed as a member of the board.

(2) The executive director of the board shall promptly notify, or cause to be notified, the appointing authority of any member who fails to satisfy the attendance requirement as prescribed in subdivision (b)(1).

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
