AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 37; Title 39 and Title 40, relative to judicial diversion.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 40-35-313(a)(1)(B)(ii), is amended by inserting the following new subdivisions:

- () Patronizing prostitution from a person who is younger than eighteen (18) years of age or has an intellectual disability, as described in § 39-13-514(b)(3);
- () Promoting the prostitution of a minor, as described in § 39-13-515(c)(1);

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
