A RESOLUTION to call a joint convention of the Senate and House of Representatives for the purpose of hearing a State of the State address by Governor Bill Lee.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE HUNDRED ELEVENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, THE SENATE CONCURRING, that the Senate and House of Representatives meet in joint convention on Monday, March 4, 2019, at 5:45 p.m. (CST) in the chamber of the House of Representatives for the purpose of hearing the State of the State address by the Honorable Bill Lee, Governor of Tennessee.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Governor Lee be invited to address the joint convention on Monday, March 4, 2019, at 6:00 p.m. (CST) in the chamber of the House of Representatives.
