WHEREAS, she retired from two Fortune 500 companies, Federal Express, where her role was to ensure participation of minorities and women in procurement practices, and International Business Machines (IBM); and

WHEREAS, Ms. Washington is an exemplary individual; her commitment to excellence and community service is representative of the Volunteer State, and she should be specially recognized; now, therefore,
