WHEREAS, a highly respected member of her community, Lana Frogge has raised funds to support local women's shelters and child advocacy centers; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Frogge epitomizes the spirit and commitment that are characteristic of a true Tennessean; and

WHEREAS, we find it appropriate to acknowledge and applaud Lana Frogge for her dedication to the State of Tennessee and its citizens; now, therefore,
