## **SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 41**

A RESOLUTION to provide for a joint committee of the House of Representatives and the Senate to count and compare the vote in the November 2018 general election for Governor.

WHEREAS, Section 2 of Article III of the Constitution of Tennessee requires the publication of the returns of every election for Governor in the presence of a majority of the members of each house of the General Assembly to determine the election and to declare the results; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDRED ELEVENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING, that the speakers of the respective houses are authorized and directed to appoint a joint committee consisting of three (3) members of the House of Representatives and three (3) members of the Senate to count and compare the vote in the November 2018 general election for Governor of the State of Tennessee.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that such joint committee shall meet at 2:30 p.m. (CST) in House Hearing Room V, Cordell Hull Building, on Tuesday, January 8, 2019, to count and compare the vote in the November 2018 general election for Governor of the State of Tennessee and shall report the results to the joint convention convening on Saturday, January 19, 2019.
