## SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 199

A RESOLUTION to confirm the appointment of Thomas L. "Tommy" Woods of Piney Flats to the Tennessee Fish and Wildlife Commission.

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 70-1-201, provides for the creation of the Tennessee Fish and Wildlife Commission; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 70-1-201, further provides that the Governor shall appoint nine members to the commission; and

WHEREAS, Governor Bill Lee has appointed Thomas L. "Tommy" Woods of Piney Flats to a term that will expire on February 28, 2025, as a member representing the 1st District; and

WHEREAS, a highly successful businessman, Mr. Woods is the co-founder and manager of Acorn Electrical Specialists, Inc., a mid-sized industrial/commercial electrical contracting company; and


