A RESOLUTION to honor and commend Kadyn Page for his heroic actions on September 16, 2019.

WHEREAS, we are honored to recognize those young citizens whose quick thinking and decisive actions have saved the lives of those in peril; and

WHEREAS, Kadyn Page, a fifth-grade student at Pleasant Hill Elementary School, became a hero of the highest caliber when he helped seven children exit an overturned bus after a traffic accident; and

WHEREAS, on September 16, 2019, ten-year-old Kadyn sprang into action after a traffic accident involving a vehicle and a church bus en route from Pleasant Hill Elementary School to the after-school care program at First United Methodist Church in Crossville; and

WHEREAS, Kadyn helped seven of the ten children riding the bus release their seat belts and safely exit the overturned bus; and

WHEREAS, the crash resulted in six children and the adult driver, who was pregnant, being transported to the hospital for observation; and

WHEREAS, the presence of mind and quick thinking of young Kadyn to take immediate action surely prevented any further harm from befalling the accident victims; and

WHEREAS, we wish to extend our gratitude and approbation to this exemplary young Tennessean; now, therefore,
