HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 37

A RESOLUTION to authorize transmittal of the budget document and legislation implementing the budget for fiscal year 2021-2022 and to call a joint convention of the Senate and House of Representatives for the purpose of hearing a State of the State address by Governor Bill Lee.

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 3-1-108, provides for a joint convention of the Senate and House of Representatives to be called annually for the purpose of hearing a State of the State address by the governor; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE HUNDRED TWELFTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, THE SENATE CONCURRING, that the Senate and House of Representatives meet in joint convention on Monday, February 8, 2021, at 5:45 p.m. (CST) in the War Memorial Auditorium for the purpose of hearing the State of the State address by the Honorable Bill Lee, Governor of Tennessee.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Governor Lee be invited to address the joint convention on Monday, February 8, 2021, at 6:00 p.m. (CST) in the War Memorial Auditorium.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 9-4-5105, the General Assembly authorizes the transmittal of the state budget document or documents for fiscal year 2021-2022 prior to the close of business in both houses on Monday, February 8, 2021.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 9-4-5105, the General Assembly authorizes the transmittal and filing of the legislation necessary to give legal sanction to the budget for fiscal year 2021-2022 prior to the close of business in both houses on Thursday, February 11, 2021.
