WHEREAS, Jack Crider's noteworthy achievement is a tremendous source of pride for his family, his school, and his community; and


WHEREAS, Mr. Crider's dedication to excellence is clearly deserving of the respect, admiration, and commendation of the members of this General Assembly; now, therefore,
