WHEREAS, throughout the 2021 legislative session, Ms. Stansbury has surpassed all criteria that define a devoted and conscientious legislative intern; and


WHEREAS, Sarah Stansbury has performed her many duties with extraordinary insight and rare decorum; now, therefore,
