WHEREAS, throughout the 2022 legislative session, Ms. Beaty has surpassed all criteria that define a devoted and conscientious legislative intern; and


WHEREAS, Savannah Beaty has performed her many duties with extraordinary insight and rare decorum; now, therefore,
