WHEREAS, a champion for children, Mrs. Mills served as the first African-American president of the Tennessee Alliance for Children, which has a statewide membership of more than 10,000 employees and seventy-five private providers who serve over 50,000 foster care children and families; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Mills is a member of the United Way Agency Executives and a member of the board of directors of the American Humanics, Adult Day Care Licensing Standards, and the National Association of Social Workers; and

WHEREAS, a proud member of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc., she was appointed to the City of Memphis Advisory Council for Citizens with Disabilities by the mayor of Memphis; and

WHEREAS, a devoted wife, mother, and grandmother, Susan Mills enjoys the love and support of her husband, the Reverend Bruce L. Mills, and their two wonderful children and four treasured grandchildren; and

WHEREAS, throughout her estimable career, Susan Mills has been committed to excellence and community service, and she should be specially recognized; now, therefore,
