WHEREAS, throughout the 2022 legislative session, Mr. Nash has surpassed all criteria that define a devoted and conscientious legislative intern; and


WHEREAS, Sha'mar Nash has performed his many duties with extraordinary insight and rare decorum; now, therefore,
