HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 130

A RESOLUTION approving the amendments and revisions to the Tennessee Rules of Evidence, promulgated by the Supreme Court of Tennessee pursuant to the provisions of Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 16, Chapter 3, Part 4.

WHEREAS, on December 14, 2021, the Supreme Court of Tennessee, acting pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 16, Chapter 3, Part 4, filed an order promulgating certain amendments and revisions to the Tennessee Rules of Evidence, previously promulgated and adopted by the Court; and

WHEREAS, on January 13, 2022, a certified copy of such order, together with a certified copy of the proposed amendments and revisions to the Tennessee Rules of Evidence, was reported and filed with the General Assembly by the Chief Justice for approval by a resolution of both houses; and

WHEREAS, such amendments and revisions to the Tennessee Rules of Evidence have been duly considered by the House of Representatives of the One Hundred Twelfth General Assembly of the State of Tennessee; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE HUNDRED TWELFTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, that the amendments and revisions to the Tennessee Rules of Evidence, as promulgated and adopted by the Supreme Court in its order dated December 14, 2021, a copy of which was filed with the Clerks of the House of Representatives and Senate on January 13, 2022, as aforesaid, are hereby ratified and approved.
