WHEREAS, throughout the 2022 legislative session, Konstantin Yepifantsev has surpassed all criteria that define a devoted and conscientious legislative intern; and


WHEREAS, Konstantin Yepifantsev has performed his many duties with extraordinary insight and rare decorum while living the American Dream in his own way; now, therefore,
