WHEREAS, dedicated to serving the needs of her community, Ms. Bevis has raised more than \$5,000 for the Children's Miracle Network and over \$8,800 for the Miss Tennessee Scholarship Foundation; and

WHEREAS, Tally Bevis is one of Tennessee's most noteworthy citizens, and it is most fitting that we honor her at this time; now, therefore,
