WHEREAS, throughout the 2022 legislative session, Alisha Siddiqui has surpassed all criteria that define a devoted and conscientious legislative intern; and


WHEREAS, Alisha Siddiqui has performed her many duties with extraordinary insight and rare decorum; now, therefore,
