HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 208

A RESOLUTION to elect Landon Colvard, Jr., to the nominating commission to select candidates for the director of the Tennessee Bureau of Investigation.

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 38-6-101, establishes a commission whose duty it is to nominate three candidates of experience and ability in the detection of crime, whenever the governor is called upon to appoint the director of the Tennessee Bureau of Investigation (TBI); and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 38-6-101, directs the Speaker of the House of Representatives to name two persons, one from each political party, to serve as members of the TBI nominating commission, such persons to be elected by resolution of the House of Representatives; and


WHEREAS, House Speaker Cameron Sexton has nominated Landon Colvard, Jr., to serve a six-year term of office as a Democratic member of the TBI nominating commission; and

WHEREAS, Landon Colvard, Jr., is a man of integrity and an active citizen who has always sought to serve the common good; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE HUNDRED TWELFTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, that this body elects Landon Colvard, Jr., to serve a six-year term of office as a member of the TBI nominating commission, such term to commence immediately and to expire on January 1, 2028.
