HOUSE BILL NO. 1534

AN ACT to repeal Chapter 396 of the Private Acts of 1947 and Chapter 358 of the Private Acts of 1959, and any other acts amendatory thereto, relative to the position of county service officer.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Chapter 396 of the Private Acts of 1947, as amended by Chapter 358 of the Private Acts of 1959, and any other acts amendatory thereto, is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. This act shall have no effect unless it is approved by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the legislative body of Anderson County. Its approval or nonapproval shall be proclaimed by the presiding officer of Anderson County and certified to the secretary of state.

SECTION 3. For the purpose of approving or rejecting the provisions of this act, it shall be effective upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it. For all other purposes, it shall become effective as provided in Section 2.
