SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 170

A RESOLUTION to confirm the appointment of Scott LeRoy to the advisory board of the University of Tennessee at Chattanooga.

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-9-501, established advisory boards for the University of Tennessee, Knoxville; University of Tennessee at Martin; University of Tennessee at Chattanooga; and University of Tennessee Health Science Center; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-9-501, provides that the governor shall appoint five members to each advisory board; and

WHEREAS, Governor Bill Lee has appointed Scott LeRoy to serve as a member of the advisory board for the University of Tennessee at Chattanooga for a term that expires on June 30, 2026; and

WHEREAS, Scott LeRoy is a managing partner at LeRoy Law Firm in Chattanooga; he was originally appointed to the advisory board of the University of Tennessee at Chattanooga in 2018 and currently serves the board as its chair; and


WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-9-501, provides that each member appointed by the governor to the advisory board for the University of Tennessee at Chattanooga shall be confirmed by the general assembly; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDRED THIRTEENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING, that this body does hereby confirm the appointment of Scott LeRoy to the advisory board for the University of Tennessee at Chattanooga for a term that expires June 30, 2026.
