## **SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 303**

WHEREAS, Ms. Davenport has been selected as the 2022–2023 Grades 9-12 Teacher of the Year for Kingsport City Schools, a most befitting honor that recognizes the positive influence she has on so many young lives; and

WHEREAS, a health science teacher at Dobyns-Bennett High School, Regina Davenport is an extremely talented and compassionate educator who works assiduously to motivate her students to reach their full potential, both as scholars and as citizens; and

WHEREAS, before entering the education field, Ms. Davenport worked as a registered nurse in medical/surgical units, pain management, and psychiatric nursing throughout the Tri-Cities area; and

WHEREAS, using the wealth of knowledge gained through her extensive career in health care, Ms. Davenport began her tenure in education in 2000 in Sullivan County as a health science instructor through career technical education before moving to Kingsport City Schools at Dobyns-Bennett in 2014; and

WHEREAS, since then, she has taught various courses, including Health Science Education, Medical Therapeutics, Rehabilitative Careers, Pharmacological Science, and Pharmacy Tech Clinical Internship. She also serves as an adjunct faculty instructor at East Tennessee State University (ETSU), where she teaches Introduction to Health Professions; and

WHEREAS, Regina Davenport received her associate degree in nursing from ETSU, a bachelor's degree in nursing from King University, and a master's degree in education from Union College; and

WHEREAS, Regina Davenport serves as an inspiration to her colleagues and students alike, and her friendship and counsel are highly valued by those who are fortunate to know her; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Davenport truly epitomizes the dedicated teacher who is wholly committed to the highest ideals of public service and quality education for all, and she should be specially recognized; now, therefore,
