PAYMENT OF REWARDS IN CERTAIN CRIMINAL CASES

There is provided by the 2012 General Appropriations Act, Chapter 1029 of the Public Acts of 2012, an appropriation for emergency and contingency for any purposes authorized by law, for which no appropriation or for which inadvertently insufficient appropriation has been made, or for any public purpose within the implication of law for which no express appropriation is made.

I. There is sufficient balance in this appropriation, and expense of the following items should be provided therefrom:

From Code 353.00 Emergency and Contingency \$30,000.00

1. To Code 351.00 Miscellaneous Appropriations..... \$20,000.00


I am directing two payments of \$10,000.00 each in satisfaction of a reward offered by the State of Tennessee on May 8, 2012, in the abduction and kidnapping of Jo Ann Bain and her three minor children, Kyliyah Bain, Alexandria Bain, and Adrienne Bain.

2. To Code 351.00 Miscellaneous Appropriations..... \$10,000.00

I am directing payment of \$10,000.00 in satisfaction of a reward offered by the State of Tennessee on October 12, 2009, in the homicide of James Mullins.

It is therefore ordered that a transfer be made out of said emergency and contingency appropriation to defray the expense of the previous items and that the Commissioner of Finance and Administration notify the Chief of Accounts to include the transfer in the work program allotment.
