**PARDON**

**TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETINGS:**

**WHEREAS**, in July of 2008, in the Criminal Court for Knox County, Tennessee, Najeeb Farhat was convicted of driving under the influence (case no. 87782); and

**WHEREAS**, Tennessee's constitution and statutory law authorize the governor to grant executive clemency, including the power to issue pardons; and

**WHEREAS**, this case appears to me to be a proper one for the exercise of executive clemency for the following reasons:

Following his offense, Mr. Farhat served in the Army National Guard for ten years prior to his honorable discharge in 2019. He seeks to continue serving his community in law enforcement. The Tennessee Board of Parole recommended granting a pardon to Mr. Farhat.

**NOW THEREFORE**, I, Bill Lee, Governor of the State of Tennessee, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by Article III, Section 6 of the Tennessee Constitution and by the laws of the State of Tennessee, do hereby grant a pardon in favor of Mr. Najeeb Farhat, pardoning him for his 2008 conviction of driving under the influence.
