PARDON

TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, between January of 2001 and October of 2004, Tara Woods was convicted in the General Sessions Court of Hamilton County, Tennessee, of assault (case no. 910482); passing worthless checks (case nos. 930069 and 932300); speeding and driving on a revoked license (case nos. 1043975 and 1043977); and speeding (case no. 1124237); and

WHEREAS, Tennessee's constitution and statutory law authorize the governor to grant executive clemency, including the power to issue pardons; and

WHEREAS, this case appears to me to be a proper one for the exercise of executive clemency for the following reasons:

Ms. Woods has been an active volunteer in her community, including at school and athletic events for her children and grandchildren. Ms. Woods has earned her commercial driver license, and she aspires to run a transportation business. Ms. Woods is a proud mother and an inspiration to others in her community. The Tennessee Board of Parole recommended granting a pardon to Ms. Woods.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Bill Lee, Governor of the State of Tennessee, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by Article III, Section 6 of the Tennessee Constitution and by the laws of the State of Tennessee, do hereby grant a pardon in favor of Ms. Tara Woods, pardoning her for her 2001 through 2004 convictions listed above.
