
Proclaiming Anderson Pond Public Hunting Area

Pursuant to the authority granted by Title 70, Tennessee Code Annotated, Sections 70-1-206 and 70-5-101, the Tennessee Fish and Wildlife Commission hereby proclaims the following area as a public hunting area to be known as Anderson Pond Public Hunting Area.


Those lands and waters in northwestern White County in Tennessee west and north of Walnut Grove Road, east of Highway 111 and south of Van Elrod Road owned by the Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency.

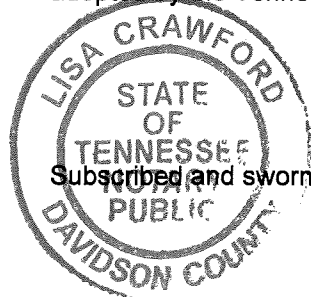
