PROCLAMATION NO. 20-09

REPEALING PROCLAMATION 14-09 AND AMENDING PROCLAMATION 08-02
NORTH CUMBERLAND WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT AREA

Pursuant to the authority granted by Title 70 Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 70-1-206, Section 70-4-107, and Section 70-5-101, the Tennessee Fish and Wildlife Commission hereby repeals Proclamation 14-09 and proclaims the following amendment to Proclamation 08-02, North Cumberland Wildlife Management Area:

Proclamation 08-02 is amended by adding a new management unit to the North Cumberland Wildlife Management Area to be known as the Ed Carter Unit by adding the following to Proclamation 08-02:

Ed Carter Unit: Those lands in Campbell and Claiborne Counties in Tennessee owned by the Molpus Timberlands Management, LLC and leased by the Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency. The Ed Carter Unit comprises a total of 43,050 acres. A more complete description may be found on file in the office of Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency in Nashville, Tennessee.
