PROCLAMATION 18-14

TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF NO-WAKE ZONE ON NICKAJACK RESERVOIR

Pursuant to the authority granted by Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 69-9-209(b)(2) the Director of the Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency, in concurrence with the Tennessee Fish and Wildlife Commission, hereby proclaims the temporary suspension of Rule 1660-2-7-.19(2)(d) Nickajack Reservoir. The temporary suspension is granted in association with a TWRA marine permit issued to ODBA (Outboard Drag Boat Association) for a drag boat race to be held in the immediate vicinity of the Marion County Park boat ramp. The rule suspension is granted only to the participants and officials of the ODBA on October 12<sup>th</sup>, 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup>, 2018, from the hours of 10:00 AM until 6:30 PM each day. Measures are being taken to assure the public health, safety and welfare and the aquatic habitat are reasonably protected and that adequate public notice is given.
