Dear Mr. York:

On a recent agency rule filing, we've identified several typographical errors in the rule filing for chapter 1660-01-08 (sequence number 03-13-17, to become effective 06/14/17):

On page 1 of the filing, the amendatory language for Rule 1660-01-08-.03, states "1660-01-08-.03 Permit Requirements – Wildlife Management Areas, Refuges and Other Agency Controlled Lands, paragraph (3) subparagraph (a) is amended by removing "Refuge" from "Paint Rock Refuge", adding "Refuge" to Cypress Pond, **removing South Cherokee**, adding the following lands: Beason Creek, Beech River, Blackburn Fork, Chambers Creek, Col. Forrest V. Durand, Fort Ridge, Gray's Creek, Happy Hollow, Harp, Harts Mill, McGlothlin-Largin, Perry Switch, Spring Creek, and Tull Bottom to the table, and adding Wolf River WMA to the paragraph below the table, so that, as amended, the rule shall read:" The phrase "removing South Cherokee," should not appear in that paragraph.

Buffalo Ridge Refuge should also have been included in the amendatory paragraphs for Rules 1660-01-08-.03(a) and (c) as being added.

On pages 2 and 4 of the filing, Bridgestone/Firestone Centennial Wilderness was split into two cells and should only be in one cell.

On page 2 of the filing, Foothills appears twice in the table and should only appear in the table once.

On page 4 of the filing, Bean Switch Refuge and Bear Hollow Mountain have been corrected to appear in alphabetical order and this should have been noted in the amendatory language.
