0080-1-1-.01 APPLICATION FOR AID.

- (1) Application for state aid allotment must be made upon forms approved and provided by the Commissioner of Agriculture.
- (2) Such survey questionnaires as may be approved by the Commissioner and requested to be completed by applicants for state aid shall be answered completely and accurately. Failure to fully answer survey questionnaires may be justification for denying the applicant's request for aid.
- (3) Completed application forms must be received by the Department of Agriculture not later than the 10th day of June preceding the fiscal period (July 1-June 30) for which aid is requested.

0080-1-1-.02 LIMITATIONS. No payment of aid shall be made on the basis of premiums offered in connection with horse shows, fine arts (paintings, drawings, etc.) Model building, photography, handicrafts, public speaking, poster displays and any other items not clearly related to the improvement of agricultural products or practices.

0080-1-1-.03 RECEIPT OF AID TO BE PUBLICIZED.

- (1) Each fair or show receiving state aid funds shall cause such to be publicly known by including appropriately worded notice in its printed program or catalogue.
- (2) If no printed program or catalogue is published, notice of state aid including the amount of allotment shall be posted in a conspicuous manner on the showgrounds.
