Chapter 0240-3-20
Student Disciplinary Rules

Presented herein are proposed amendments of the Tennessee Board of Regents submitted pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated, §4-5-202 in lieu of a rulemaking hearing. It is the intent of the Tennessee Board of Regents to promulgate these rules without a rulemaking hearing unless a petition requesting such hearing is filed within thirty (30) days of the publication date of the issue of the Tennessee Administrative Register in which the proposed amendments are published. Such petition to be effective must be filed in Suite 350 of the Genesco Park Building located at 1415 Murfreesboro Road, Nashville, TN 37217 and in the Department of State, Eighth Floor, William R. Snodgrass Tower, 312 Eighth Avenue, North, Nashville, TN 37243, and must be signed by twenty-five (25) persons who will be affected by the rules, or submitted by a municipality which will be affected by the rule, or an association of twenty-five (25) or more members, or any standing committee of the General Assembly.

The text of the proposed amendments is as follows:

Amendments

1. Paragraph (3) (including subparagraphs and parts) of Rule 0240-3-20-.06 Traffic and Parking Regulations is amended by deleting the text of the subparagraphs and parts and substituting the following language, so that, as amended, paragraph (3) shall read:

(3) Penalties.

- (a) Fines for violation of traffic and parking regulations will be set by the college through the annual incidental fees and charges recommendations submitted to the Tennessee Board of Regents in accordance with TBR Guideline B-060: VIII: B(2).
- (b) All violations of parking in the areas designated for handicapped parking will result in a fine of \$100.00 or a fine amount established by Tennessee State law.

2. Part 6. of subparagraph (b) of paragraph (5) of Rule 0240-3-20-.06 Traffic and Parking Regulations is further amended by deleting the text of the part and substituting the following language, so that, as amended, part 6. shall read:

- 6. Parking and traffic violation cases involving employees may be appealed to the Vice President for Business Affairs.

3. Subparagraph (c) of paragraph (2) of Rule 0240-3-20-.07 Motor Vehicle Registration is amended by deleting the text of the subparagraph and substituting the following language, so that, as amended, subparagraph (c) shall read:

- (c) A campus access fee will be assessed each term for each student. This fee will be assessed in addition to maintenance and registration fees. Employees will be assessed a campus access fee each year. One parking hang tag will be issued to each student and employee at no cost. A second parking hang tag may be requested by students or employees at an additional charge as set forth in the other fees and charges recommended by the college and approved by the Tennessee Board of Regents in accordance with TBR Guideline B-060: VIII:B(2).

The proposed rules set out herein were properly filed in the Department of State on the 16th day of January, 2007 and pursuant to the instructions set out above, and in the absence of the filing of an appropriate petition calling for a rulemaking hearing, will become effective on the 31st day of May, 2007.
