Statement of Necessity

The Tennessee Board of Regents is required, as a result of the enactment by the Legislature of Public Chapter 909, to amend its institutional parking rules pursuant to the procedures set forth in Tenn. Code Ann. § 4-5-209 for the promulgation of "Public Necessity Rules." Public Chapter 909 amends Tenn. Code Ann. § 55-21-108 and increases the mandatory fine(s) for disabled/handicapped parking violations to \$200.00, effective July 1, 2008. The proposed amendment is necessary to bring the Board's rule(s) into compliance with State law.

Rule 0240-01-01-.06 Disabled/Handicapped Parking Violations is amended by creating a new rule to be included in the Board's system-wide rules governing Use of Campus Property and Facilities so that as amended the rule shall read:

The fine for disabled/handicapped parking violations is established by State law and will increase as needed to remain in compliance with State law. This rule supersedes all rules or notices regarding fines for disabled/handicapped parking violations at any TBR institution.

The public necessity rules set out herein were properly filed in the Department of State on the 29th day of October, 2008 and will be effective from the date of filing for a period of 165 days.
