Chapter 0240-04-01
Student Housing Rules

Presented herein are proposed amendments of the Tennessee Board of Regents submitted pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated § 4-5-202 in lieu of a rulemaking hearing. It is the intent of the Tennessee Board of Regents to promulgate these rules without a rulemaking hearing unless a petition requesting such hearing is filed within thirty (30) days of the publication date of the issue of the Tennessee Administrative Register in which the proposed amendments are published. Such petition to be effective must be filed in Suite 350 of the Genesco Park Building located at 1415 Murfreesboro Road, Nashville, TN 37217 and in the Department of State, Eighth Floor, Tennessee Tower, William R. Snodgrass Building, 312 Eighth Avenue North, Nashville, TN 37243, and must be signed by twenty-five (25) persons who will be affected by the rule, or submitted by a municipality which will be affected by the rule, or an association of twenty-five (25) or more members, or any standing committee of the General Assembly.

The text of the proposed amendments is as follows:

Amendments

Paragraph (1) of Rule 0240-04-01-.04 Visitation Policy is amended by deleting the text of the paragraph and substituting the following language so that as amended the paragraph shall read:

(1) Visitation hours for all residence halls: 8:00 a.m. - midnight, seven (7) days a week. Emerald Hill Complex visitation hours shall be twenty-four (24) hours a day.

Paragraph (2) of Rule 0240-04-01-.06 Reservations (Deposit, Cancellation and Refund Policies) is amended by deleting the text of the paragraph and substituting the following language so that as amended the paragraph shall read:

(2) Request for cancellation of the contract must be approved by the Director of Housing Residence Life. Failure to make a request for cancellation of contract by July 1 for the academic year or November 1 for new applications for the spring semester will result in forfeiture of the prepayment fee. Applications submitted after these dates will be subject to automatic forfeiture of the prepayment fee upon cancellation.

Subparagraph (i) of paragraph (1) of Rule 0240-04-01-.07 Special Regulations Applicable to Particular Housing Facilities is amended by deleting the text of the subparagraph and substituting the following language so that as amended the subparagraph shall read:

(i) The maximum number of occupants residing in Emerald Hills shall be: One (1) bedroom apartments: a maximum of two (2) occupants; two (2) bedroom apartments: a

maximum of four (4) occupants; three (3) bedroom apartments: a maximum of six (6) occupants.

The proposed rules set out herein were properly filed in the Department of State on the 12th day of November, 2008, and pursuant to the instructions set out above, and in the absence of the filing of an appropriate petition calling for a rulemaking hearing, will become effective on the 30th day of March, 2009.
