Amendment

Part 26. of subparagraph (b) of paragraph (1) of rule 1200-13-14-.04 Covered Services is amended by adding a paragraph in the “Benefit For Persons Under Age 21” column so as amended part 26. shall read as follows:

SERVICE	BENEFIT FOR PERSONS UNDER AGE 21	BENEFIT FOR PERSONS AGED 21 AND OLDER
<p>26. Pharmacy Services [defined at 42 CFR §440.120(a) and obtained directly from an ambulatory retail pharmacy setting, outpatient hospital pharmacy, mail order pharmacy, or those administered to a long term care facility (nursing facility) resident].</p>	<p>Covered as medically necessary. Certain drugs (known as DESI, LTE, IRS drugs) are excluded from coverage.</p> <p>Pharmacy services are the responsibility of the PBM, except for pharmaceuticals supplied and administered in a doctor’s office, which are the responsibility of the MCO.</p> <p>For TennCare Standard children under age 21 who are Medicare beneficiaries, TennCare pays for medically necessary outpatient prescription drugs when they are covered by TennCare but not by Medicare Part D. Pharmaceuticals supplied and administered in a doctor’s office to persons under age 21 are the responsibility of the MCO if not covered by Medicare.</p>	<p>Not covered.</p>
